Phonics	*The Letter "F" Get Ready For The Code - Book A: Pages 1-9 *Teacher's Guide pages 8-10 *Writing in sand activity - Letter "F" and "f" *Read Aloud: "My F Book" - ask students to recall words that began with "F"	*Get Ready For The Code - Book A: Pages 10-12 *Search for items in your home that begin with the letter "F" (floor, folder, flag, finger, fork, feet, face, fridge, etc). Have the student say the letter name, the sound of the letter, and the name of the object they found. "F says /f/ as in fork."	*Read Aloud: "Alphatales: Fifi Ferret's Flute." Discuss final page. *Put together Alphatales booklet for home. *Writing in sand activity - numbers and letters *Kindergarten Workbook: Page 23	*Read Aloud: "Alphatales: Fifi Ferret's Flute."
